

# EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

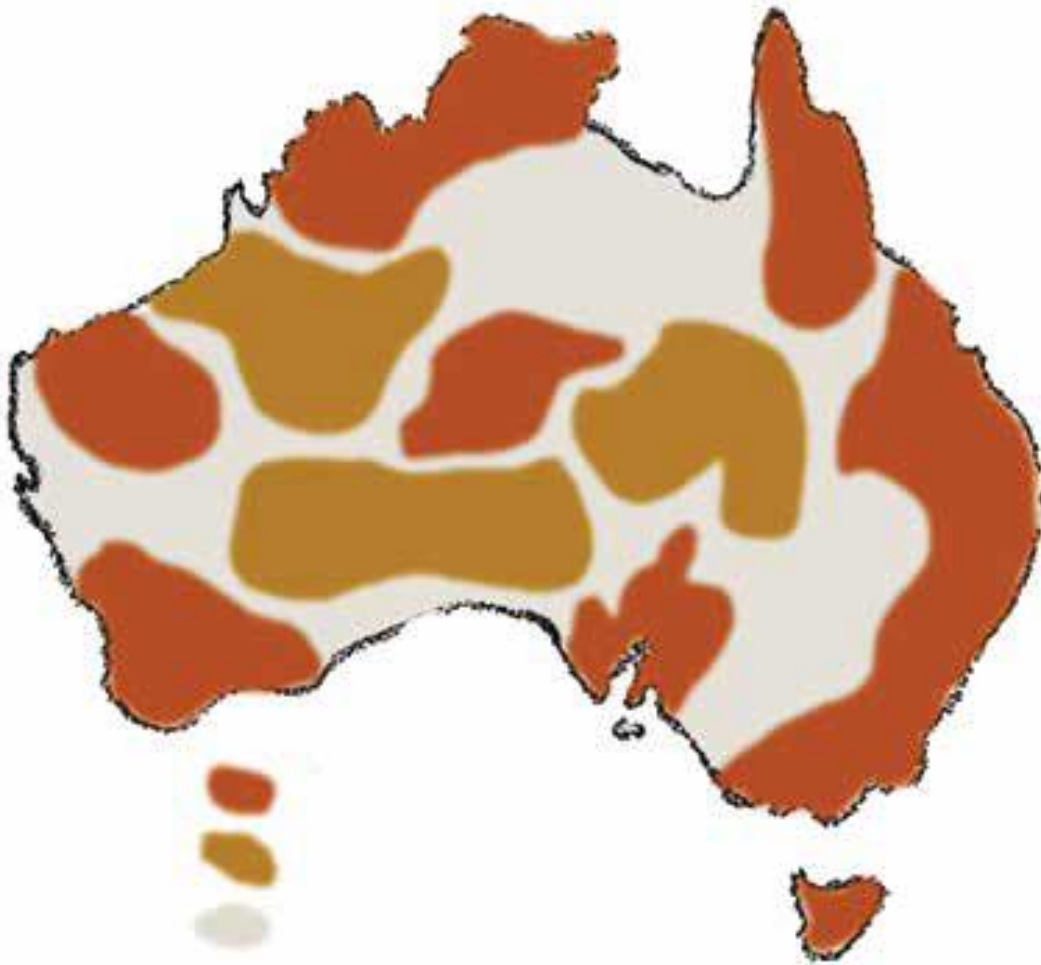
These activities are for students who require extension after completing all the tasks in *Ancient Australia Unearthed*.

## Arrival: Page 24-25

Design a boat to travel to Australia. The only tools you have are scrapers and stone axes. You may use fire, as well as anything from the natural environment. Label your boat with explanations that tell us how you made it.

## Dispersal: Page 28-29

Using the map below, chart the quickest and safest route from Darwin to Perth.



### Rock Shelters: Page 36-37

Design your own rock shelter. Make sure you include areas for sleeping, cooking, and preparing food. You may also wish to include rock art that depicts your daily activities or spiritual stories, and an area for making stone tools.

### Riwi Cave: Page 38-39

Imagine you live in Riwi Cave, 35,000 years ago. Explain how these shells got to Riwi Cave, how valuable they are to you, and what you traded for them.

### Rock Art: Page 46-47

You have travelled to another country where you can't speak the language. You need to explain something that you love (e.g. football or music). Draw what you want to communicate.

### Dutch: Page 68-69

Imagine you have spotted a Dutch ship for the first time. Describe what you see and how this makes you feel.
